Thank you for the opportunity and recommendation to approve the annual Homeless Response contracts. LifeMoves is fortunate to enjoy an ongoing partnership with the City of Mountain View. Our clients and the broader community have benefited from previous support, and we appreciate the consideration, especially in these leaner budget years, where the needs are significant and the funding is limited.

Homekey Mountain View provides temporary housing for individuals and families experiencing homelessness. There are 80 units for single individuals, eight units for couples, and 12 family units. The community at MTV is seeing greater numbers of disabled and aging individuals with varying wants and needs when it comes to housing. The attention needed for a population with unique barriers to permanent housing will be available and accessible at the site with an open-door policy for all program participants.
