Brief Description: (talent, programming, target audience, etc.)

The new Teatro Nahual theatrical performance is "El Marido Cornudo"/"The Cheated Husband" from the playwright Moliere and adapted by Verónica Meza. This comedy is performed in Spanish. It presents how the important values in a marriage: love, respect, trust, and loyalty are broken because of the miscommunication and jealousy that don't allow to find balance and peace in a marriage. The comedy is enriched with live music and dance.

A specific community being served:

Teatro Nahual is a group of playwrights, actors, musicians, designers, painters, educators, and acting students. Our art form is manifested through the theater arts entirely in Spanish. A strong commitment, professionalism, dedication, and passion for the theater arts have been the primary motivation to continue directing, acting, writing, adapting, and promoting the Spanish language plays for the Hispanic population and for people interested in expanding their culture and language appreciation in California. Our creative process is based on providing the Hispanic community with theater performances that will help create social consciousness and awareness.

Teatro Nahual's Mission:

Teatro Nahual is a Non-Profit Organization 501 c 3 founded in 2003 and based in Santa Clara County. The mission is to promote education and entertainment to the Latino community through Spanish language plays, including dance, music, and any art manifestation. We have offered Spanish acting classes for children, youth, and adults since 2004. The acting courses are based on the university thesis written by Verónica Meza, director and founder of Teatro Nahual.

How will this event benefit the community?

Teatro Nahual, the new Spanish language, "El Marido Cornudo," can offer education and entertainment to the Hispanic population. It can be a good opportunity for the Mountain View Performing Arts to capture the attention of different audiences that speak Spanish as a first or second language around the Bay Area.

We believe that the immigrant population can adapt to a new society without forgetting its origins and values, which, after all, are the only aspects that make a human being complete and dignified in a community. Therefore, the Spanish language plays can be a vehicle to transmit educational entertainment and provoke a change, a revolution, in the audience's mentality by reflecting on its customs and traditions and fortifying the identity.

Other Sources of funds (Such as Grants and corporate contributions)

Teatro Nahual has received operation funds from the SVCreates organization to cover basic expenses, such as the fees for the rental of a classroom for practicing and acting classes at Mountain View Community Center. Also, some operation funds from California Arts Council to offer a donation to Teatro Nahual's director, music teacher, and set designer.

Why do you need a fee waiver (please attach a summary of your organization's financial situation?

We consider it significant that Mountain View for the Performing Arts offers the opportunity to community theaters like Teatro Nahual to have the experience of performing in a traditional theater like the SecondStage. Teatro Nahual's fundraising focuses on covering the expenses to pay the high costs of alternative spaces to perform our plays. Consequently, the actors and talent receive a minimum donation for their creative work. With this fee waiver opportunity on the Second Stage, we can focus on the new performance production and give an honorarium to the actors who dedicate many hours to theater practices and performances. It will make a big difference to release the rental fee for Teatro Nahual's finances, especially during and post-pandemic.
