## BACKGROUND

The Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) Members' Manual was compiled by staff in 2020 with the intention of orienting new and existing members to BPAC procedures, clarifying protocols for executing duties, and providing information and resources that may assist in carrying out the role of a BPAC member.

The BPAC is also subject to the Brown Act (California Government Code Section 54950, *et seq*.), which is intended to promote transparency and public participation in local government in California.
