A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A 200-WORD MAXIMUM FOR A CANDIDATE'S STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS AND CHARGING EACH CANDIDATE FOR A FIXED SHARE OF COSTS OF THE PRINTING AND HANDLING FOR THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2014

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Mountain View that:

- 1. The Statement of Qualifications for each candidate in the General Municipal Election to be held Tuesday, November 4, 2014, shall not exceed 200 words pursuant to Campaign Ordinance No. 4-06, adopted by the City Council on April 25, 2006.
- 2. As provided by Ordinance No. 4-06, candidates who file a statement of acceptance of the Voluntary Expenditure Limit (VEL) and pay the first \$500 toward the cost of translation of the Candidate's Statement of Qualifications into Chinese, Spanish, Tagalog, and Vietnamese, as required by the Federal Voting Rights Act, and the cost of printing and handling said Statement of Qualifications at the time nomination papers are filed, will be eligible to have the City pay for the balance of the cost of the statement subject to certain limitations.
- 3. No other candidate election materials will be permitted in the sample ballot for said General Municipal Election to be held Tuesday, November 4, 2014.
