## **RECOMMENDATION**

Adopt a Resolution Amending City Council Policy K-2—Council Advisory Body Appointments, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 1 to the Council report).

## **BACKGROUND**

On February 10, 2015, the City Council approved the recommendations of the Council Procedures Committee to clarify Council Policy K-2—Council Advisory Body Appointments.

Specifically, the City Council amended the policy to state a person is not required to be a registered voter in order to serve as a member of any advisory body (including the Human Relations Commission) other than those advisory bodies required by the City Charter. The City Council also revised the policy to require non-Charter advisory body appointees to either take the constitutional loyalty oath, or if the person is not a U.S. citizen, to take an alternate oath tailored to each specific advisory body. Finally, the City Council amended the policy to state an individual appointed to more than one advisory body can only serve on one advisory body at a time.

To effectuate the amendment, it is necessary to adopt a resolution setting forth the amendments. The resolution helps create a clear legislative record of the changes to the policy over time. The attached resolution memorializes the changes approved by the City Council at the February 10, 2015 meeting and includes the amended language in the policy, which is also attached to the resolution.
