6. **NEW BUSINESS**

6.1 ELECTION OF CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR

Motion – M/S — Cox/Capriles – Carried 6-0-1; Trontell absent – Elect Ellen Kamei as Chair of the Environmental Planning Commission for 2015.

Motion—M/S Matichak/Scarboro—Carried 6-0-1; Trontell absent—Elect Margaret Capriles as Vice Chair of the Environmental Planning Commission for 2015.

6.2 PARK LAND DEDICATION ORDINANCE

Senior Administrative Analyst Kiner gave an oral staff report.

No members of the public wished to speak.

Staff answered questions raised by the EPC.

1. **Motion**—M/S Capriles/Matichak—Carried 5-1-1; Cox no, Trontell absent—Redefine the size and service area of parks:

Park Type	Size	Service Area
Mini-Park	Up to 1 acre	1 mile
Neighborhood Park	1 up to 5 acres	1 mile
Community Park	≥ 5 acres	Entire City

- 2. **Motion**—M/S Matichak/Fernandez—Carried 6-0-1; Trontell absent—Increase the number of park acres required from 3 to 5 acres per 1,000 residents.
- 3. **Motion** M/S Capriles/Cox Carried 6-0-1; Trontell absent Reduce the credit provided to developers for private open space to zero.
- 4. **Motion**—M/S Matichak/Cox—Carried 6-0-1; Trontell absent—Charge commercial subdivisions for impacts to parks, trails, and recreational facilities. This requires a nexus study.
- 5. **Motion**—M/S Cox/Capriles—Carried 5-1-1; Scarboro no, Trontell absent—Not to apply the density floor area ratio to the gross project site; leave as-is.
- 6. Motion—M/S No motion/No second (00:56:30)—Carried 6-0-1; Trontell absent—Recommend City Council not require the dedication of land on all developments with greater than 50 new dwelling units and allow staff to make a recommendation based on the merits of each development.
- 7. **Motion**—M/S Fernandez/Scarboro—Carried 4-2-1; Capriles, Cox no; Trontell absent—Recommend the City Council provide a 100 percent credit on Park Land Dedication requirements or fees in lieu thereof on 100 percent affordable housing projects.
