TITLE: Residential Parking Permit Program

(Second Reading)

## **RECOMMENDATION**

Adopt an Ordinance Amending Chapter 19 to Create a Residential Parking Permit Program. (First reading: 7-0)

## **SUMMARY**

On October 4, 2016, the City Council introduced an ordinance amending Chapter 19 to create a Residential Parking Permit Program (see Attachment 1—Ordinance), and a resolution authorizing the City Manager to promulgate Residential Parking Permit Guidelines. The motion was carried 7-0. The motion to set the level of on-street parking occupancy to qualify for the Residential Parking Permit at 75 percent; allow two permits per household, with the cost of \$5 a month for the first car and \$10 for the second car; and set the cost of \$5 per month for guest permits was carried 6-1; Siegel no, and will be incorporated into the Program Guidelines.

This is the second reading of the ordinance for approval. If approved, the ordinance will become effective on November 24, 2016.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

The fiscal impact of implementing a residential parking permit program was included in the Council report introducing the Ordinance.
