TITLE: **Ordinance Amendment Regulating the Use of City Trails (Second Reading)**

RECOMMENDATION

Adopt an Ordinance Amending Chapter 38 of the Mountain View City Code, Regulating the Use of City Parks and Other City Facilities, Article IV, Regulating the Use of City Trails, to Amend Section 38.201 and Delete Section 38.202 (Attachment 1 to the Council report). (First reading: 7-0)

SUMMARY

On November 22, 2016, the City Council introduced an ordinance amending Chapter 38 of the Mountain View City Code to permit the use of electric-assist bicycles and electric scooters, as defined by the California Vehicle Code, and skateboards, on trails and to permit, for a one-year trial period, the use of electric skateboards, as defined by the California Vehicle Code, on trails. This is the second reading of the ordinance. If approved, the ordinance will become effective 30 days after the second reading.
