


It all starts on the playground!

- Outdoor play is the foundation for physical development, as well as social-emotional lessons such as cooperation, sharing, problem solving and kindness. Without inclusive playgrounds, many families do not have a place to bring their children to play.

MOTOR SKILLS


Fine Motor • Agility • Balance • Cardiovascular Coordination • Eye-hand coordination • Endurance Motor Planning

The Community

According to the U.S. Census of 2010, nearly 25.4 million families have at least one member in their family with a disability, making this the largest minority group, and one that each of us can become a member of at any time.

Magical Bridge Playgrounds are designed to address the complex needs of the entire population living with disabilities, from the physical to the cognitive. It is important to note that only 10% of those with disabilities are physically affected; autism, cognitive and developmental issues, sensory challenges and many other differences make up the other 90%. The first of its kind, Magical Bridge Playground considers everyone.
