## **Recommended Projects/Activities/Initiatives**

# Goal 1: Promote strategies to protect vulnerable populations and preserve the socioeconomic and cultural diversity of the community.

Current Item

- 1. Review and provide input on plaza usage.
- 2. Review and provide input on the Financial Assistance Program.
- 3. Support the construction of the Community Center renovation and expansion, in conjunction with the Public Works Department, while implementing plans to maintain operations and programming during that time.

### Possible Future Items

1. Partner with Magical Bridge Foundation to develop a Magical Bridge Playground in Mountain View.

# Goal 2: Improve the quantity, diversity, and affordability of housing with an added focus on middle income and ownership opportunities.

CSD and PRC do not have any current or possible future items that meet this goal.

# Goal 3: Develop and implement comprehensive and coordinated transportation strategies to achieve mobility, connectivity, and safety for people of all ages. <u>Current Item</u>

1. Updates on trail usage following 1-year implementation (motorized skateboards)

### Possible Future Items

- Support the design and construction of the Stevens Creek Trail from Dale/Heatherstone to West Remington and Mountain View High School.
- 2. Coordinate with the Mountain View Whisman School District on the construction of Permanente Creek Trail from Rock Street to Middlefield Road.
- 3. Improve landscaping at Bonny/Beatrice Streets along the Hetch-Hetchy corridor.
- 4. Develop the Hetch-Hetchy corridor from El Camino Real to Fayette Drive.
- 5. Explore the feasibility of connecting Charleston Retention Basin to Stevens Creek Trail.
- 6. Explore the feasibility of an east-west trail corridor from Sunnyvale to Palo Alto, south of Central Expressway and north of El Camino Real, to include consideration of the Caltrain corridor as a possible option.
- 7. Explore the feasibility of a trail along the Permanente Creek Right-of-way across Central Expressway, connecting Crisanto Avenue and Escuela Avenue with the Hethc-Hetchy right-of-way.
- 8. Explore the feasibility of improving the Bay Trail connection between the western and eastern sides of the Stevens Creek Trail.

## **Recommended Projects/Activities/Initiatives**

9. Continue to collaborate with Sunnyvale, Cupertino, and Los Altos to build upon the 4 Cities Feasibility Study to share costs, leverage support for grants, and continue to support the extension of the Stevens Creek Trail.

## Goal 4: Promote environmental sustainability with measurable outcomes.

#### Current Items

- 1. Review and provide input on construction of Community Gardens at Shoreline and Latham.
- 2. Continue the Shoreline at Mountain View Master Plan Project, in conjunction with the Public Works Department.
- 3. Continue to implement the Urban Forestry Management Plan guidelines for tree preservation and planting, with particular emphasis on street trees and canopy goals.
- 4. Continue to monitor and participate in Santa Clara Valley Water District's project: construction of McKelvey Park/Ball Field and Schaefer park, in conjunction with the Public Works Department.

Possible Future Items

- 1. Support design and construction of Fayette and Wyandotte Parks, in conjunction with the Public Works Department.
- 2. Assist with the design of South Whisman Park, in conjunction with the Public Works Department.
- 3. Assist with the design of Evandale Park, in conjunction with the Public Works Department.
- 4. Assist with the Graham Athletic Field Synthetic Turf Replacement Project, in conjunction with the Public Works Department.
