## BACKGROUND

Fifteen (15) applicants reapplied/applied for the vacancies on the Library Board; Human Relations, and Parks and Recreation Commissions; and the Downtown, Performing Arts, and Senior Advisory Committees. The Council Appointments Review Committee (CARC) met on November 6, 2017, interviewed candidates and considered the incumbents for these vacancies, and discussed recommendations for appointments.

At the direction of the Council Appointments Review Committee, staff contacted the members of the Senior Advisory Committee who will be terming out to see if they were interested in serving another term. One member had recently resigned since he moved out of the area. Another member has joined the Age Friendly Cities Task Force. There was no response from another member. The Committee recommends readvertising the vacancies on the SAC.

The City Council interviewed two (2) candidates for the Environmental Planning Commission at a Study Session on November 7, 2017.
