TITLE: Cuesta Tennis Courts Resurfacing,

Project 17-26 – Accept Construction

RECOMMENDATION

Accept Cuesta Tennis Courts Resurfacing, Project 17-26, and authorize the final contract payment.

BACKGROUND

On May 16, 2017, the City Council authorized the award of the construction contract for Cuesta Tennis Courts Resurfacing, Project 17-26, and authorized award of the construction contract if the low bid was within the project budget. The contract was awarded to First Serve Productions, Inc., of Discovery Bay, California, at the low bid price of \$73,971 which included a \$12,000 construction contingency. On July 31, 2017 the construction contingency was increased by \$23,000 in order to repair large cracks, increasing the total contract amount to \$96,971. The project resurfaced all 12 tennis courts and pathways, and installed a long-term crack repair system.

ANALYSIS

The final construction cost of \$91,971 is within the construction budget of \$96,971 and includes a change order for additional striping and large crack repair. All work has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications.

FISCAL IMPACT

Cuesta Tennis Courts Resurfacing, Project 17-26, is funded with \$218,300 from the Construction/Conveyance Tax Fund.

The total project expenditure, including design, project administration, construction inspection, and other costs is estimated to be \$118,000. Remaining funds will be used for future court resurfacing projects at Stevenson and Rengstorff Parks.

ALTERNATIVES

Determine that the improvements have not been completed in conformance with City standards and decline to accept the improvements until they are completed to the satisfaction of the Council.
