RECOMMENDATION

Accept 2016-17 Street Lane Line and Legend Repainting, Project 17-12, and authorize the final contract payment.

BACKGROUND

On May 24, 2016, the City Council authorized the award of the construction contract for 2016-17 Street Lane Line and Legend Repainting, Project 17-12, to Safety Striping Services, Inc., of Goshen, California, at the low bid price of \$315,611, including a \$50,000 construction contingency. The work included repainting traffic lanes, pavement legends, crosswalks, red curbs, and school-related legends on all City streets.

ANALYSIS

The final construction cost of \$243,504 is within the construction budget of \$315,611 and includes one change order and a final item adjustment change order resulting in contract savings of \$22,107. All work has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications.

FISCAL IMPACT

2016-17 Street Lane Line and Legend Repainting, Project 17-12, is funded with \$453,000 from the Construction/Conveyance Tax Fund. The total project expenditure is approximately \$377,000. The remaining balances will be returned to the original funding source when the projects are closed.

ALTERNATIVES

Determine that the improvements have not been completed in conformance with City standards and decline to accept the improvements until they are completed to the satisfaction of the Council.
