# **RECOMMENDATION**

Accept Park Irrigation Pump Installation (Cooper Park), Project 16-45, and authorize the final contract payment.

# BACKGROUND

On November 28, 2017, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for Park Irrigation Pump Installation (Cooper Park), Project 16-45, and authorized award of the construction contract if the low bid was within the project budget. The contract was awarded to John Clay General Engineering Contractor, Inc. at the low bid price of \$74,510, which included a \$15,000 construction contingency. The project installed a 7.5-horsepower booster pump to provide adequate pressure in Cooper Park's irrigation system.

# ANALYSIS

The final construction cost is \$54,610. No contingency was used, and one change order was approved resulting in a contract savings of \$4,900. All work has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications.

# FISCAL IMPACT

Park Irrigation Pump Installation (Cooper Park), Project 16-45, is funded with \$920,000 from the Park Land Dedication Fund, which also funds the improvement of three other City parks (Bubb, Whisman, and Stevenson Parks). The Cooper Park project expenditure is approximately \$95,000. The remaining funds will remain in the project budget to fund improvements at Bubb, Whisman, and Stevenson Parks.

# **ALTERNATIVES**

Determine that the improvements have not been completed in conformance with City standards and decline to accept the improvements until they are completed to the satisfaction of the Council.
