This is an application to remove the front-yard redwood tree at 1577 Latham Ave. Mountain View, a property that we have owned for 30 years.

As background, the house dates to 1946, the likely date when the tree was planted. Recently it's become apparent that the tree has caused substantial damage to the house foundation, as discovered in the recent Foundation Damage report. Please find the relevant pages attached to this Application.

The tree's trunk has grown to within 2 feet of the structure. The roots have grown up around the corner of the house, un-leveling the floor and cracking the foundation. The tree has grown over the gas utility line, obscuring access to it. The attached pictures show the proximity of the tree and the extent of its growth

Sadly, discussions with local arborists have not found a solution to avoid further damage short of removing the tree. One should keep in mind that partial removal, or trimming of the roots would only postpone additional remedies. In short, we've loved the tree and the benefits it offers, and will be sad to see it go, and expect to replace it when we renovate the landscaping in its place.
