STATISTICS



In FY17-18 we provided food assistance to 40,877 unique individuals (this is an undercount because not all agencies report on food for the safety net contract).



In FY17-18 we assessed 1,674 unduplicated households at risk of homelessness.



In FY17-18 We provided 215 households with comprehensive homelessness prevention assistance, including temporary financial assistance, case management, and access to legal services. 96% of households remained stably housed while receiving prevention assistance.

About the Network


Everyone experiences emergencies from time to time. For some Silicon Valley residents, however, each day is a struggle for financial stability and independence. When an emergency hits, they need somewhere to turn for help. The goal is to stabilize individuals and families during times of trouble and help them return to self-sufficiency.

The Emergency Assistance Network (EAN) agencies in Santa Clara County provide a variety of services to prevent homelessness, utility disconnections, and hunger. Services include:

- One-Time Rent and Mortgage Payment Assistance
- Move-In Costs for Rental Deposits
- One-Time Utility Assistance
- On-Site Information and Referrals, e.g MediCal, CalFresh (Food Stamps), Food Pantries
- Other Services may include: Food Distributions, Case Management, Job Training, Employment Assistance, Low-Income Utility Programs, After-School Care, Backpacks and School Supplies, Veterans Assistance, Housing Search Assistance, Temporary Shelter Services

Levels & Guidelines of Assistance

- Assistance levels are limited by funding available this does not include in-kind support to these families of food, clothing, etc.
- Assistance from agencies is based on zip code residence
- Income eligibility guidelines related to low and very low income
- Strict criteria for rental assistance is followed i.e. payments are made to landlords not to the client
- Direct financial assistance for transportation, utilities, medical, etc.
- Limits on the amount of funding and the time span in which funding is received—most agencies give one time only assistance.
