## North Bayshore Precise Plan Principles

The following is a list of the relevant Precise Plan principles that provide high level guidance to inform the policy development of the Gateway Master Plan. A more complete description of each principle is included in the North Bayshore Precise Plan, pages 7-10. Below is brief description of the high level strategies for how the Plan will initially address each principle; further refinement of these strategies will be presented later in this Plan process as necessary.

- 1) **Create a Gateway to North Bayshore.** The Plan will include strategies such as visible, key buildings and entry signage along Shoreline Boulevard to help foster a sense of entering a special district within Mountain View.
- 2) **Create Complete Neighborhoods.** The Plan will include a broad mix of land uses as generally outlined in this report to create a "complete neighborhood" in this area of North Bayshore.
- 3) **Create Distinct Areas.** The Plan will be distinct from surrounding areas---more intensive, with a mix of building types and heights to make it unique from other areas.
- 4) **Expand and Improve Public Spaces.** New publicly accessible open space will be designed in the Plan area, including publicly accessible streets and bike and pedestrian facilities.
- 5) **Construct Buildings that Support Public Areas.** The Plan requires buildings with a more urban orientation---buildings will be placed close to public sidewalks and open space, and building designs will include frontage elements to encourage more pedestrian activity and interaction.
- **6) Promote Retail, Entertainment, and the Arts.** *The proposed land use program includes retail and entertainment uses.*
- 7) **Promote Economic Diversity.** *The Plan will include a variety of spaces for different types of economic activity (office, retail, entertainment, fitness, services, etc.).*
- 8) **Create Walkable, Human-Scale Blocks.** *The Plan will include a grid like system to create blocks that make walking convenient and accessible for pedestrians.*
- **9) Connect to Surrounding Districts and Neighborhoods.** *The Plan will be oriented to integrate to both the Shoreline Boulevard corridor and the Joaquin Street corridor to the north.*
- **10) Improve Connectivity/Transportation.** *The Plan includes a connection across Highway 101 with a new bicycle and pedestrian bridge.*
