TITLE: 2020 Council Meeting Schedule

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the 2020 City Council meeting schedule.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

The following schedule is intended to be a "master calendar" for City Council meetings for calendar year 2020. In general, the schedule calls for the Regular City Council Meetings to be held the second and fourth Tuesdays of the month as specified in the City Charter, with Special City Council Meetings scheduled as needed on alternate Tuesdays to consider additional business items or conduct Study Sessions. In addition, the schedule provides for a summer and holiday season "meeting break" per Council practice.

This schedule takes into consideration known conferences, events, and observed holidays (listed on Page 3); however, Councilmembers are encouraged to let staff know in advance of any other conflicts and bring their calendars to the meeting in the event that the item is pulled for discussion or changes.

By the end of the 2019 calendar year, a total of 38 meetings will have been held, which has included Goal Setting, Team Building, and three additional meetings that were not on the calendar initially adopted by Council in November 2018. In 2018, 32 meetings were held; in 2017, 33 meetings were held. (These meeting counts do not include any Closed Sessions for Council appointee recruitment.) In 2020, 31 meetings are proposed.
