## RECOMMENDATION

Receive and review the updated Interactive Bikeway Map.

## **BACKGROUND**

As part of the City's work on the Comprehensive Modal Plan, staff has updated the City's geographic information system (GIS) layers on various topics, including current and planned bikeways in the City. As a result of this effort, an updated Interactive Bikeway Map has been generated and is now available for use at the City's GIS portal. The updated map is regularly used for a variety of planning efforts while the back side of the City's printed bike maps provides an opportunity for information and education. For example, the back side of the 2016 Printed Bicycle Map features bicycle safety tips and associated images. In 2019, the City adopted a new bicycle ordinance, and a summary of local and State riding rules have been provided on the City's website.

## **DISCUSSION**

Staff plans to use the 2020 Interactive Bikeway Map as the basis for an updated printed bike map. The back side of the printed map will include a summary of local and State riding rules and selected bike safety tips.

Staff seeks Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee input on the updated Interactive Bikeway Map as well as priorities for information to include on the back side of the map.
