## **PURPOSE**

Interview seven applicants for one opening on the Rental Housing Committee (unexpired term ending April 17, 2021).

## DISCUSSION

In July and early August 2020, the City Clerk's Office conducted a recruitment to fill one vacancy on the Rental Housing Committee (RHC) for an unexpired term ending April 17, 2021. Eight applications were received during the recruitment period that concluded on August 14, 2020. One applicant was unavailable to attend an interview this evening.

The Community Stabilization and Fair Rent Act (CSFRA) specifies the RHC composition and eligibility requirements. The eligibility requirements for RHC members include:

- All members are required to be residents of the City of Mountain View;
- No more than two members of the RHC own or manage any rental property or are real estate agents or developers; and
- Anyone nominated to the RHC must be in compliance with the CSFRA and all other local, State, and Federal laws regulating the provision of housing.

Currently, one member of the RHC, Matt Grunewald, owns or manages rental property.
