## CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW RESOLUTION NO. SERIES 2020

## A RESOLUTION ORDERING THE VACATION OF A PUBLIC SERVICE EASEMENT AT 2300 WEST EL CAMINO REAL

WHEREAS, the City of Mountain View has elected to proceed under the provisions of the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easement Vacation Law, commencing with Section 8300 and, in particular to Chapter 4, Sections 8333 and 8334, regarding summary vacation of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, to summarily vacate certain public service easements for such uses as public utilities, cable television, and other similar uses situated within the corporate limits of said City, and more particularly described and shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said provisions, the City Council may summarily vacate (no public hearing required) said easement described above; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found, from all the evidence submitted, that the easement described above has been unused for the purpose for which it was dedicated for five consecutive years prior hereto and superseded by relocation at the time of vacation, and it is unnecessary for present or prospective public use; and

WHEREAS, the vacation is necessary for the development application by BPR Properties Mountain View, LLC, for a new 153-room hotel (Application No. PL-2019-312); and

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2017, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18145 approving the Vacation of the Public Utility Easements (Application No. 033-16-PCZA); and

WHEREAS, said resolution was not recorded at the County Recorder's Office, building permits were not issued, and the previous entitlements have expired;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Mountain View that, from all the evidence submitted, the public easement described and depicted in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, has been unused for the purpose for which it was dedicated for five years prior hereto, superseded by relocation at the time of vacation, and is unnecessary for present and prospective public uses and that, therefore, this body orders that the said public easement described herein be, and the same is hereby, vacated, subject to the conditions specified in this

Resolution pursuant to Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easement Vacation Law commencing with Section 8300.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Mountain View, in accordance with Streets and Highways Code Section 8335, finds that this Resolution shall not be recorded until the following condition has been satisfied: File with the City of Mountain View approved improvement plans, agreements, and performance bonds for the new public streets and related improvements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pursuant to Section 8336(a) of the California Streets and Highways Code, the City Clerk is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded in the Office of the Recorder of the County of Santa Clara, and that, from and after the date this Resolution is recorded, the public service easement herein vacated no longer constitutes a public service easement.
