

Interviews



PURPOSE

Interview seven applicants for three openings (terms ending April 17, 2025) and one alternate opening (unexpired term ending April 17, 2023) on the Rental Housing Committee.

DISCUSSION

The City Clerk's Office conducted a recruitment to fill three openings (terms ending April 17, 2025) and one alternate opening (unexpired term ending April 17, 2023) on the Rental Housing Committee (RHC) from January 29 to February 26, 2021. Seven applications were received during the recruitment period that concluded on February 26, 2021.

The Community Stabilization and Fair Rent Act (CSFRA) specifies the RHC composition and eligibility requirements. The eligibility requirements for RHC members include:

- All members are required to be residents of the City of Mountain View;
- No more than two members of the RHC own or manage any rental property or are real estate agents or developers; and
- Anyone nominated to the RHC must be in compliance with the CSFRA and all other local, State, and Federal laws regulating the provision of housing.

Currently, one member of the RHC, Matt Grunewald, owns or manages rental property.
