
## SAFE PARKING PARTICIPANT DEMOGRAPHIC DATA

During the period of April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021, the Mountain View safe parking lots served 96 households (vehicle units) comprised of 184 individuals. Of these individuals, 36 were children, and 46 were aged 55 and above. Seventy-eight (78) of the individuals identified as female, 103 identified as male, one identified as trans female, and one identified as gender nonconforming. Data has not been collected for one individual.

Sixty-two (62) of the individuals and/or households identified as Hispanic/Latino, four identified as Asian, and four identified as Black/African American.

## Economic Data

Economic data is often not a reliable indicator of economic stability. Income is reported on intake and may fluctuate while in the program. The data is reported for individuals and/or households. The program data shows that, during the past year, 16 of the lot participants have reported an income. Ten (10) have been employed and reported an average income of \$2,095, two receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and reported an average income of \$1,375, one participant receives Worker's Compensation of \$580, one participant receives \$1,080 via Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), one participant receives \$150 through General Assistance (GA), and one participant receives \$969 through retirement income from Social Security.

## Other Data

There are currently 16 participants who have reported a disability, of whom eight have a physical disability, four have a developmental disability, and eight individuals have mental health challenges. Eleven (11) participants reported having a chronic health condition, and one participant reported dealing with substance abuse.
