## **PURPOSE**

Review the City Council approved Fiscal Year 2021-22 Public Safety Advisory Board (PSAB) Work Plan

## BACKGROUND

On August 26, 2021, the PSAB prioritized work plan items and recommended a Fiscal Year 2021-22 Public Safety Advisory Board (PSAB) Work Plan to the City Council. On September 28. 2021, the City Council reviewed recommended PSAB work plan and approved the work plan with modifications. The modified PSAB Work Plan is in Table 1 below. Item 3 was modified from "Explore alternative responses to persons experiencing mental health crises" to "Explore existing and alternative responses to persons experiencing mental health crises" and Item 5 was added to the work plan: "Receive presentation on the Mountain View Police Department Proposed Fiscal Year 2022-23 Budget."
