5. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

5.1 <u>Fiscal Year 2017-18 Work Plan Final Discussion</u>.

Assistant City Manager Ramberg presented an oral staff report that summarized the proposed list of projects for the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Work Plan, staff's analysis and assessment of each work plan item, and recommendations for HRC consideration for final work plan adoption.

- 2. Conduct a needs and assets assessment to learn more about the resources, services, policies, and programs that are currently available for immigrant communities that reside in Mountain View.
- 3. Develop a scope of work that identifies the issues, process, objectives, desired outcomes and feasibility of developing a recommendation to the City Council to consider expanding voting rights for non-citizens in school board or municipal elections.
