- Dan Sakols expressed concern for Downtown Mountain View. He is concerned that downtown Mountain View will turn into Sunnyvale and lose the older buildings, and all that creates an urban center.
- Lorrie Robbins expressed concern about the quality of life in Mountain View and feels Mountain View should grow in a slow smart way. Instead the growth in Mountain View has been singular and unusual. She expressed concern that the thirty year old Downtown Precise Plan is behind the times and at risk of turning the downtown area into an office park.
