5.1 Tenant Relocation Assistance Ordinance Modifications

Housing and Neighborhood Services Manager Tim Wong and Community Stabilization and Fair Rent Act (CSFRA) Program Manager Anky Van Deursen gave an oral presentation and responded to questions by the EPC.

MOTION - M/S - Cranston / Hehmeyer - That the Environmental Planning Commission:

- 1. Adopt a Resolution Recommending that the City Council adopt an Ordinance Amending Article XIII of Chapter 36 of the Mountain View City Code Related to Tenant Relocation Assistance, to include the following modifications:
- a. Increase the income eligibility for TRAO, adjusted by household size, by an additional \$5,000;
- b. Increase the amount of additional relocation assistance for special-circumstance households from \$3,000 to \$5,000;
- c. Require enhanced assistance by a relocation agency in searching for replacement housing;
- d. Require County recording of Notice of Ellis Act/TRAO requirements;
- e. Add language specifying if tenants are eligible for relocation benefits under State or Federal law, tenant's relocation benefits shall be consistent with whichever law provides the greatest level of benefit; and
- f. Amend Section 36.38.25.a.3 to clarify if alternative housing or vacation of unit, whichever occurs first.
