Miramonte Avenue Improvements, Project 20-01-Various Actions

- Find that in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requirements, Miramonte Avenue Improvements, Project 20-01, is categorically exempt as Class 1, Existing Facilities and Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land, under CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301 and 15304.
- Approve the road diet alternative for Miramonte Avenue Improvements, Project 20-01, between Cuesta Drive and Castro Street as recommended by the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee and Council Transportation Committee.
- Adopt a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Mountain View Approving a Request to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission for the Allocation of Fiscal Year 2023-24 Transportation Development Act Article 3 Pedestrian/Bicycle Project Funding, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 1 to the Council report).
- Accept \$346,497 in Transportation Development Act Article 3 Pedestrian/Bicycle Project Funding and appropriate the funds to Miramonte Avenue Improvements, Project 20-01. (Five votes required)
- Authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all documents and agreements, and take all necessary actions related to the acceptance of Fiscal Year 2023-24 Transportation Development Act Article 3 funding.
