The Environmental Planning Commission recommends the City Council:

1. Adopt a Resolution Amending the P-40 (San Antonio) Precise Plan to Prohibit Cannabis Businesses within the San Antonio Precise Plan Boundaries, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 1 to the Council report).

- Introduce an Ordinance Amending Article IX, Division 21, to Limit Storefront Retail Businesses to a Maximum of One in the P-19 (Downtown) Precise Plan Boundaries (Chapter 36 of the City Code), to be read in title only, further reading waived, and set a second reading for June 11, 2019 (Attachment 2 to the Council report).
- Introduce an Ordinance Amending Article IX, Division 21, to Establish a Minimum 600' Distance between Cannabis Businesses (Chapter 36 of the City Code), to be read in title only, further reading waived, and set a second reading for June 11, 2019 (Attachment 3 to the Council report).

Staff also requests the City Council provide policy direction on how to proceed with the cannabis business permitting process.
