Adopt Resolutions Authorizing the City Manager or His Designee to Set the Compensation for Unrepresented Employees, Including Confidential Employees, Fire Managers, Police Managers, Department Heads, Hourly Employees, and Council Appointees for the Period of July 1, 2017 Through June 30, 2020, and to Revise the City's Salary Plan to Reflect These Compensation Changes as follows:

Adopt a Resolution Authorizing the City Manager or His Designee to Set the Compensation for Unrepresented Confidential Employees, Fire Managers, Police Managers, Department Heads, and Council Appointees, for July 1, 2017 Through June 30, 2020, and Revise the City's Salary Plan to Reflect These Compensation Changes, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 1 to the Council report).

Adopt a Resolution Authorizing the City Manager or His Designee to Set the Compensation for Unrepresented Hourly Employees for July 1, 2017 Through June 30, 2020 and Revise the City's Hourly Salary Plan to Reflect These Compensation Changes, to be read in title only, further reading waived (Attachment 2 to the Council report).
