Community Lived Experience Survey	Develop and administer a community survey to gain insight on the lived experience and quality of life in Mountain View.	<u>High</u> – Community-wide survey requiring scope, definition, survey design, extensive outreach, and analysis.	Serve as a liaison/facilitator between City government and the public.	Similar to the City of Palo Alto <a href="#">NPHI Lived Experiences Survey</a> . City is administering statistically significant citywide surveys in the context of exploring a revenue measure. Staff is exploring regular community feedback surveys.
Community Stability & Affordability	Create a project about community stability as it relates to affordability and a sense of belonging.	<u>High</u> – undefined event program/scope	Serve as a forum for public discussion on issues relating to involvement.	Similar to FY 23-24 housing instability event.
Partnership with Schools	Partner with schools in Mountain View.	<u>High</u> – undefined program/scope and goals or purpose.	Not specifically aligned with HRC scope.	The City has longstanding partnerships both formal and informal across initiatives, programs, and departments.
