Type of Tree: LIQUIDAMBAR (TREE #1) – (FACID #7785)

Upon the completion of a field inspection, Forestry Division staff has determined that the request to have the tree/trees removed be:

<u>CONDITION OF TREE/CONDITIONS AFFECTING THE TREE</u>: Tree conflicts with proposed driveway on submitted building plans. Redesign of proposed home and driveway was explored but not a viable option due to State-approved modular design. Located approximately 3 feet from existing sidewalk, damage was found to sidewalk and private driveway. Root removal for future sidewalk repairs is likely to compromise health and/or stability of tree.

Any person wishing to appeal this action must file an appeal (Fee \$50) with the City Clerk's Office, 500 Castro Street, Mountain View, CA. The Office is open for drop-ins Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. It is recommended to call and make an appointment at (650) 903-6304. Appeals must be submitted by **5:00 p.m., May 14, 2025.**

One of the two requests to remove three private Heritage trees was approved. Please continue reading for more information.

Your request to remove one (1) Liquidambar (FACID #7785) heritage street tree (as identified in your application - Tree #1) has been approved after a field inspection and review by the Forestry & Roadway Landscape Division.

Your removal request is defined by the City Ordinance, Article I, in accordance with the Mountain View City Code, Article II, Section 32.35, Paragraph (2), which states:
