SUBJECT: Final Safe Routes to School Report for Fiscal Year 2023-24

RECOMMENDATION

Receive the final report for the Mountain View Safe Routes to School Program for Fiscal Year 2023-24.

BACKGROUND

On <u>March 27, 2024</u>, the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) received the *Mountain View Safe Routes to School Program 2019-2023 Report*. The report documented the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) activities, including safety training, bike rodeos, suggested route maps, and student and parent survey summaries.

ANALYSIS

The final *Mountain View Safe Routes to School Program 2023-2024 Report* (Attachment 1) documents SRTS program activities and events in Mountain View for Fiscal Year 2023-24. The final report also corrected the student tally mode-share calculation from the December 12, 2024 meeting. The final report is also available at <u>MountainView.gov/saferoutes</u>.

In Fiscal Year 2024-25, the City is continuing education and encouragement activities, including safety assemblies and bike rodeos at all elementary, middle, and high schools as well as Citywide events, such as the Monster Bash Bike Circus. Staff is also developing infrastructure recommendations based on the walk audits from 2023. Staff also continues to work with Mountain View Whisman School District staff on school-specific SRTS curricula.

NEXT STEPS—Staff will provide an update to BPAC on SRTS activities in June 2025.
