A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY MOUNTAIN VIEW
AMENDING THE LIST OF DESIGNATED POSITIONS
REQUIRED TO FILE STATEMENTS OF ECONOMIC INTEREST

WHEREAS, under state law, the City of Mountain View is required to adopt a list of specified positions, which involve decision-making or participation in decision-making that may affect economic interests of the official or employee, and once designated is required to make certain disclosures regarding their sources of income, such as investments, interest in real properties, and any business positions held outside of their employment with the City, in order to avoid potential conflicts of interest; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 87200 specifically requires the following positions to file Statement of Economic Interest forms: mayors, city councilmembers, planning commissioners, city managers, city attorneys, city treasurers, and other public officials who manage public investments; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is appropriate to amend Appendix A, the list of designated positions, to reflect the addition, elimination, renaming, reclassification, and new designation of positions and officials in the City, in order to bring the City's Conflict of Interest Code up to date for those positions and officials required to file a Statement of Economic Interest; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that Appendix A, the list of designated positions required to file financial disclosure statements, is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit A to this Resolution, and the disclosure categories of the list of designated positions shall be governed by Appendix B as set forth in Exhibit B to this Resolution. Exhibits A and B of this Resolution are attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

* Consultants, as required under Government Code Sections 82019 and 82048, and as defined under California Code of Regulations, 2 CCR § 18700.3, are included in the list of designated positions and shall disclose pursuant to Category 1, subject to the following limitation:

The City Manager may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a “designated position,” is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and, thus, is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant’s duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of

disclosure requirements. The City Manager's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code. (Gov. Code § 81008.)

Appendix B

GENERAL PROVISION

An employee holding a designated position is required to disclose any financial interests, which include some or all of the following: investments, real property interests, and other sources of income. An employee need only disclose investments of business entities and sources of income which do business in the City, plan to do business here, or have done business in the City within the past two years, unless otherwise specifically changed in the disclosure categories specified below. Income from the City need not be disclosed. In addition to other activities, a business entity is doing business with the City if it owns real property here. Business position disclosure includes businesses in which the employee is a director, officer, partner, trustee, employee, or holds any position of management. When an employee holding a designated position is required to disclose interests in real property, that employee need only disclose real property, which is located in whole or in part within or not more than two miles outside the boundary for the City or within two miles of any land owned by the City of Mountain View. The principal residence or any other property used as a personal residence of the employee need not be disclosed. Employees holding a designated position shall disclose their financial interests pursuant to the appropriate disclosure categories as described in Appendix A.

DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

- Category 1— All investments and sources of income, including personal and business entity income, all interests in real property, and all business positions.

- Category 2— All investments in business entities, sources of business entity income, and business positions of the type which, within the past two years, have contracted with the City or which may reasonably be expected to contract with the City, or which may reasonably be expected to contract with the City within one year from the date of the latest Statement of Economic Interest to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment.

- Category 3— All investments in business entities, sources of business entity income, and business positions of the type which, within the past two years, have contracted with the City or where it is reasonably foreseeable that the business entity or source will contract with the City within one year from the date of the latest Statement of Economic Interest to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment to the designated employee's department.
