A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW, ACKNOWLEDGING  
RECEIPT OF THE MOUNTAIN VIEW FIRE DEPARTMENT'S ANNUAL INSPECTION REPORT  
PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE SECTION 13146.4

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3 require all fire departments that provide fire protection services, including the Mountain View Fire Department, to perform annual inspections in every building used as a public or private school, hotel, motel, lodging house, apartment house, and buildings and accessory structures for compliance with building standards and other regulations adopted by the State Fire Marshall, as provided; and

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4 requires fire departments, including the Mountain View Fire Department, to report annually to its administering authority on its compliance with inspections performed pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Sections 13146.2 and 13146.3; and

WHEREAS, Educational Group E occupancies are generally those public and private schools used by more than six (6) people at any one time for educational purposes through the 12th grade. Within the City of Mountain View, there lie sixty-eight (68) Group E occupancies, buildings, structures and/or facilities; and

WHEREAS, during calendar year 2025, the Mountain View Fire Department completed the annual inspection of sixty-eight (68) Group E occupancies, buildings, structures, and/or facilities, indicating a compliance rate of one hundred percent (100%) for this reporting period; and

WHEREAS, Residential Group R (R-1 and R-2 subcategories) occupancies, for the purposes of this resolution, are generally those occupancies containing sleeping units and include hotels, motels, apartments (three (3) units or more), etc., as well as other residential occupancies (including a number of residential care facilities). These residential care facilities have a number of different subclassifications and may contain residents or clients that have a range of needs, including those related to custodial care, mobility impairments, cognitive disabilities, etc. The residents may also be non-ambulatory or bedridden. Within the City of Mountain View, there are eight hundred and seventy-four (874) Group R (R-1 and R-2 subcategories) occupancies; and

WHEREAS, during calendar year 2025, the Mountain View Fire Department completed the annual inspection of eight hundred and seventy-four (874) Group R (R-1 and R-2 subcategories) occupancies, buildings, structures, and/or facilities, indicating a compliance rate of one hundred percent (100%) for this reporting period; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mountain View intends this Resolution to fulfill the reporting requirements of California Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of Mountain View expressly acknowledges receipt of the Mountain View Fire Department's Annual Inspection Report in accordance with California Health and Safety Code Section 13146.4; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
