A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW
ACCEPTING AN ALCOHOL POLICING PARTNERSHIP GRANT FROM THE
STATE OF CALIFORNIA IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY-ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR
DOLLARS (\$51,464) TO DEVELOP A STRATEGIC APPROACH TO ELIMINATING THE CRIME AND
PUBLIC NUISANCE PROBLEMS ASSOCIATED WITH PROBLEMATIC ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE
OUTLETS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY
TO RECEIVE THE GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the State of California, Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control has awarded the Mountain View Police Department an Alcohol Police Partnership (APP) grant in the amount of fifty-one thousand four hundred sixty-four dollars (\$51,464); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant funding is to develop an effective, comprehensive, and strategic approach to eliminating the crime and public nuisance problems associated with problematic alcoholic beverage outlets; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of Mountain View hereby accepts the APP grant in the amount of fifty-one thousand four hundred sixty-four dollars (\$51,464); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of Mountain View hereby authorizes the City Manager or designee to take all steps necessary to receive the grant funding, including, but not limited to, executing a grant agreement with the State of California or other State agency or department that is administering the grant; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of Mountain View hereby accepts the APP grant in the amount of fifty-one thousand four hundred sixty-four dollars (\$51,464) to be used for enhanced alcoholic beverage enforcement; and

IT IS AGREED, that any liability arising out of the performance of this contract, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and ABC disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and

IT IS ALSO AGREED that this award is not subject to local hiring freezes; and be it
