#### **PROCESS**

INVITE

Invite city residents, business owners, workers, community leaders to share and explore ideas for the plan

**GATHER** 

Gather community input through interactive art engagement activities and surveys

CREATE

Create a public art plan that will include a vision, mission statement, objectives/guiding principles, and recommendations.

**PROVIDE** 

Provide a set of goals, policies, and objectives that will guide the development and enhancement of the public art inventory and public art program

**DEVELOP** 

Develop the public art strategy
