A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW  
AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE FROM PUBLIC ACCESS TO PARKING LOT NO. 11 FOR A  
MINIMUM OF 66 CONSECUTIVE MONTHS BEGINNING OCTOBER 2026

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the CIP 20-49, Public Safety Building Project, design and construction of a 75,000 square foot New Public Safety Building and a three-story Parking Garage at 1000 Villa Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the PS&E of the CIP 20-49, Public Safety Building Project, Package 1 – Selective demolition, site preparation, and utility coordination on June 9, 2026; and

WHEREAS, project-specific conditions stated on CIP 20-49, Public Safety Building, June 9, 2026, City Council Memo, use of Parking Lot No. 11 is proposed for temporary visitor parking, construction staging, and Police and Fire staff temporary parking, and council approval is required for use of the parking lot; and

WHEREAS, twenty-five parking spaces are needed to provide temporary visitor parking for the existing Police and Fire Admin building; and

WHEREAS, fifty-three parking spaces are needed to support long-term construction material staging for materials for CIP 20-49 Public Safety Building Project, construction; and

WHEREAS, Mountain View City Code Section 19.67 prohibits the obstruction of streets or parking lots from free use; and

WHEREAS, Parking Lot No. 11, in the block bounded by Franklin Street and Villa Street is a suitable temporary location for visitor parking, to temporarily stage and transport construction materials, and provide temporary Police and Fire staff parking; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: by the City Council of the City of Mountain View that, pursuant to Mountain View City Code Section 19.92, seventy-eight spaces within Parking Lot No. 11 are hereby temporarily closed for 66 months commencing October, 2026, as set forth in the recitals above and as may be amended and/or scheduled, to enable the use of Parking Lot No. 11 for visitor parking, to temporarily stage and transport construction materials, and provide temporary Police and Fire staff parking; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that posting and closure of the 78 parking spaces shall not occur prior to the execution of the construction contract agreement with the City of Mountain View and issuance of Notice to Proceed (“NTP”) to the contractor; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that staff is hereby directed to post appropriate signage to notice the temporary closure of 78 parking spaces within Parking Lot No. 11 and provide notification closure prior to October, 2026.

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
