A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE FISCAL YEAR 2026-27 FUNDING AGREEMENTS WITH THE COMMUNITY SERVICES AGENCY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW, LOS ALTOS, AND LOS ALTOS HILLS FOR HOUSING-RELATED SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$177,000), AND FOR A HOMELESS PREVENTION DIRECT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000)

WHEREAS, the City of Mountain View (City) has partnered with the Community Services Agency of Mountain View, Los Altos, and Los Altos Hills (“CSA”) for homeless and unstably housed-related services since 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City executed a Fiscal Year 2025-26 funding agreement to help fund housing-related services, including housing problem-solving services, housing information and referral case management services, focused outreach for individuals living in vehicles in Mountain View, and a portable restroom to support continued service delivery; and

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2025, the City Council adopted the *Pathways to Housing* plan, which includes the Council’s direction to explore a new Homeless Prevention Emergency Direct Financial Assistance Program, modeled after the successful programs during the COVID-19 pandemic, with the CSA as the Emergency Assistance Network provider; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue to partner with and provide funding to CSA for ongoing housing-related services and a new homeless prevention emergency direct financial assistance program; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of Mountain View authorizes the City Manager or designee to enter into a funding agreement with the CSA for housing-related services in an amount not to exceed one hundred seventy-seven thousand dollars (\$177,000) for a one-year term from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the City Manager or designee is authorized to enter into a funding agreement with the CSA for a homeless prevention direct financial assistance program in an amount not to exceed one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for a one-year term from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
