# 8.1 Reference and Information Services Policy

Senior Librarian, Court Fields gave a summary report on changes made to the Reference and Information Services Policy. Revisions to the policy was in collaboration with Assistant Library Director, Melvyn Yabut, Library Manager, Ann Collins and Librarians from the Youth and Bookmobile and the Customer Experience and Technology divisions. The main goal was to set clear expectations and guidelines on library services and have a policy that was streamlined and aligned with the American Library Association, Library Bill of Rights.
