4. STUDY SESSION

4.1 Environmental Planning Commission Applicant Interviews

The purpose of this study session was to interview applicants for the Environmental Planning Commission and make a recommendation for adoption at the December 17, 2024 City Council meeting.

There were no public speakers in-person or virtually.

The Council selected the following time allocation and questions to ask each Environmental Planning Commission applicant:

1 minute: What have you personally done to make a contribution to the Environmental Planning Commission, or, if you are not currently serving, what would you bring to the Environmental Planning Commission that is unique?

2 minutes: What are your thoughts on the City's existing plans like the General Plan and Precise Plans,

specifically the Downtown Precise Plan?

1.5 minutes: How would you evaluate proposals to amend the General Plan?

1.5 minutes: How does good land use improve our City, and what is good land use?

The Council interviewed the following three applicants for one member on the Environmental Planning Commission to fill one term beginning January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2028.

Hank Dempsey Tina Pham Douglas Woolverton

The Council discussed the applicants and voted by ballot.

City Clerk Glaser announced each Councilmember voted for Hank Dempsey.

Hank Dempsey was selected to fill one term on the Environmental Planning Commission beginning January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2028.
