SUBJECT: Recommendation for Zoning Permit No. PL-10104 at 302 Loreto Street

On March 24, 2025, Alexander Angkawijaya of AA Home Design & Build LLC filed a request for a Historic Preservation Permit to construct a 415-square foot addition to an existing one-story, 1,125-square foot single-family residence that is listed on the Mountain View Register of Historic Resources, on a 0.11-acre site. This project is located on the north side of Loreto Street, between Bush Street and Calderon Avenue in the R1 (Single-Family Residential) Zoning District.

City staff has completed the review of the application and is recommending approval based on the findings and conditions of approval in the attached report, including a recommendation that the project is categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15331 ("Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation") of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.

This item will be discussed at an Administrative Zoning public hearing on June 25, 2025, where a final action will be made.

Public notices were sent to all property owners within 750 feet of the project site.
