SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 ANNUAL REVIEW for HOME COMPANY UPSTAGE

THEATER

BACKGROUND:

Founded in 2015, Upstage Theater is a Bay Area theatre company wholly run by and for teenage theatre artists from all backgrounds, created to give professional level experiences across every aspect of theatrical production. They have made a dedication to creating safe spaces to examine what it means to be a teenager through play material written by or about teens that they would typically be unable to participate in in a school or community theater environment. After a year and a half of virtual productions and a strong hunger for returning to the stage, this is the first Upstage season featuring two musicals in one year.

For the year ending Dec. 31, 2023, the budgeted income was \$22,080 with \$14,280 in program revenue and \$7,800 in contributions.

ANALYSIS:
