#### 8.1 Fiscal Year 2023-24 Mid-Year Performance Measures

Library Director, Tracy Gray provided an update on the mid-year performance measures. Visits to the library are on target with over 300 thousand this mid-year. Circulation continues to increase, especially with digital materials like e-books and audio books. Program attendance continues to be steady with attendee's satisfaction feedback remaining positive. Putting on quality programs that positively impact the community. The computer stations and study rooms continue to increase with usage. Statistics for the study rooms will be added to the next performance measures in July. Numbers may be correlated to people getting out from Covid restrictions and seeing an increase during post pandemic which has since fizzled out through this fiscal year as things return to normal.

The Friends' upcoming book sale will be on the weekend of March 2-3.
