RECOMMENDATION

Forward a recommendation to the City Council for the appointment of a City Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee member as Mountain View's representative to the Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority's Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee for the term from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2026.

BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

The Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority's (VTA) Bicycle & Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) advises the VTA Board of Directors on bicycle and pedestrian projects and issues. It consists of appointed representatives from each city in Santa Clara County. The appointment term is two years, ending on June 30 of each even-numbered year. Members may be appointed to successive terms. The City's current representative on the VTA BPAC is Committee member Lada Adamic.

The City's BPAC is responsible for providing the City Council with a recommendation for the appointment of the City's representative on the VTA BPAC. The VTA BPAC bylaws have no provisions for an alternate member from member agencies.

NEXT STEPS

The City's BPAC appointment recommendation for a VTA BPAC representative will be agendized for Council review and action at a future City Council meeting. The Council's recommendation for the City's VTA BPAC representative will then be forwarded to the VTA Board of Directors for final approval.
